The Gallatin City-County Health Department will have appointment times available for school vaccinations throughout the year. Talk to your child's physician to see if they will need any vaccines prior to school schedule pickup.

We will be in Three Forks at the 3 Rivers Clinic on July 24, August 9, and August 15 by appointment only. Please call 406 582-3100 to schedule an appointment.

The pertussis and varicella vaccines are now **required** school immunizations.

Please bring your child's immunization record and insurance card to the appointment. Children with no insurance, or whose insurance does not pay for vaccines, qualify for vaccinations under the Vaccines for Children Program

2018-2019 Required Vaccinations

VACCINE	PRESCHOOL	KINDERGARTEN – 12 TH GRADE
Haemophilus influenzae Type B (Hib)	1 dose (given on or after the 1 st birthday)	None Needed
Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP, DT, Tdap)	4 doses	At least 4 doses (one given on or after 4 th birthday)
		Plus
		1 dose of Tdap (prior to entering 7 th grade)
Polio (IPV or OPV)	3 doses	At least 3 doses (one given on or after 4 th birthday)
Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)	1 dose (dose given on or after 1 st birthday)	2 doses (first dose on or after 1 st birthday)
**Varicella (chickenpox)	1 dose (dose given on or after 1 st birthday)	2 doses (first dose on or after 1 st birthday)

**All students must have evidence of immunity to chickenpox through one of the following:

- 2 doses of varicella vaccine
- Laboratory evidence of immunity or laboratory confirmation of disease
- Diagnosis or verification of history of chickenpox or shingles disease by a healthcare provider (MD, DO, NP, or PA)
